CAREER BRIEF

Dr. James Lange serves as SDSU's first Coordinator of AOD Initiatives. In that role, he developed a system of describing the functional elements of a comprehensive prevention strategy. This award-winning system has been adopted beyond SDSU, including its use within the California State University system. For over two years (2014-2016), Dr. Lange also served as SDSU's first Director of the newly autonomous Health Promotion Department within the Division of Student Affairs. In that role, he oversaw the creation of a dynamic department that seeks to improve the behavioral health of SDSU students. He also chairs the Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Strategic Plan Task Force for SDSU.

Dr. Lange also serves as the Executive Director of the Higher Education Center for Alcohol and Drug Misuse Prevention and Recovery, an academic center of The Ohio State University. The mission of the HECAOD is to promote student success nationally by providing data-driven solutions to alcohol and drug misuse. In an effort to meet this mission, HECAOD provides tools, training, and technical assistance on evidence-based strategies to campus professionals. Through the HECAOD, Dr. Lange has successfully led an effort to organize the various statewide AOD campus coalitions into the *National Consortium of Statewide Coalitions*. He serves the center through a cost-reimbursement arrangement between OSU and SDSU.

Dr. Lange's research has focused on behavioral-risk prevention, primarily studying the drinking behavior of young people. He was awarded one of NIAAA's five Rapid Response college-drinking research grants. Through this award and his other grants, Dr. Lange has focused on underage drinking, college binge drinking, and designated driver use. He has published articles in leading scientific journals on community responses to underage drinking, designated driver use, youth binge drinking, drunk driving and boating enforcement, tobacco use, prescription drug abuse, Salvia divinorum use, seat belt use, and roadside breath-test surveys.

His research and service career have earned him an international reputation within the field of AOD abuse prevention. In two consecutive years, 2014 and 2015, he was awarded the California State University Chancellor's award for his service towards statewide progress in AOD prevention. This established record of both research and community-level prevention implementation is what led the AB InBev Foundation to tap him, along with an international team of experts to assist in the Global Smart Drinking Goals: City Pilot program. Dr. Lange serves as an expert coach for selected cities attempting to implement community-level, evidence-based environmental prevention programs to reduce the harmful use of alcohol.

For over two decades, Dr. Lange has used both laboratory and field-survey methodology to conduct scientifically rigorous examinations of the cognitive effects of alcohol use and social-cognitive determinates of designated driver use. He has served as an important resource for community organizers seeking to implement environmental interventions designed to reduce or prevent binge and underage drinking. Dr. Lange serves as a science advisor for *RADD*, *The Entertainment Industry's Voice for Road Safety* and their California Coalition, a project bringing State, industry, and prevention resources together to reduce drunk driving. He has served the field by volunteering in leadership roles within various organizations, including NASPA AOD Knowledge Community, The Network Addressing Collegiate Alcohol and Other Drug Issues, and the San Diego County Binge and Underage Drinking Initiative.

Dr. Lange is committed to helping address disparities in well-being outcomes. Since 2018, he has been a recognized co-leader of the Action Network for Equitable Wellbeing (ANEW; formally known as the 20x30 Network; see https://anew.nyu.edu/who/leadership/), hosted by New York University. ANEW is structured with an *Improvement Science* approach to creating system changes to better serve all students. Through presentations and facilitation of *Action Labs*, Dr. Lange has helped campuses assess wellbeing in a meaningful way that address inequities and disparities using the free ANEW Wellbeing Improvement Survey for Higher Education Settings (see https://anew.nyu.edu/what-we-do/wishes/).

Among his contributions to SDSU campus life, he serves on the following: Senate representative for the Intercollegiate Athletics Council; member of the Young Men of Color Study Group; the Center for Skateboarding, Action Sports and Social Change; Aztec Nights Management; Dead Naming Task Force; Co-Chair of the AOD Task Force; Weber Honors College Fellow; and Wellbeing Improvement Survey for Higher Education Settings (WISHES) Steering Committee. These were designed to 1) cue the use of designated drivers, 2) change the attitudes of the group, and 3) affect group norms to support the proper use of designated drivers. Each trial used random assignment and was conducted at the San Ysidro border crossing. 2001-2004 (transferred from PIRE).

Alcohol Research Collaborative: Alternative Program (U01 AA014738 DHHS National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, Lange PI, \$624,485) The Principal Investigator (Dr. Lange) would serve both a consulting and research role for the Institutions of Higher Education (IHE). A collection of prominent college-alcohol prevention researchers has come together to form the Alcohol Research Collaborative (ARC). While each individual researcher has broad research experience, each also possesses identifiable areas of unique expertise. Together these areas of expertise represent the fulfillment of a comprehensive approach to college alcohol abuse prevention. 2003-2009.

CHOICES/e-CHUG Development Project (R43 AA015002 DHHS National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, Lange PI, \$22,500) The project was a collaboration with The Change Companies on the proposed creation of an e-CHUG version of the CHOICES alcohol education program. Data collection occurred on the SDSU campus, under the direction of Dr. James Lange. His offices conducted both focus groups of students, as well as the classroom trials of the new program materials. The project tested the feasibility of new versions of the CHOICES alcohol abuse prevention product line for college students to develop an integrated assessment and feedback instrument to incorporate into the existing products. 2004-2005.

Investigating Collegiate Natural Drinking Groups (R21 AA016800, DHHS National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, Lange PI, \$317,039) The project investigated collegiate drinking-group construction, motivations, and dynamics. A better understanding of these phenomena provides insights into the general phenomenon of college students' alcohol abuse and helps guide future intervention efforts. To achieve this general aim, the research developed and tested a paradigm for measuring processes of naturally occurring collegiate drinking groups. The research advanced our ability to measure and understand the dynamics of natural drinking groups within the context of college drinking behavior. 2008-2011.

ARRA: Disclosing Contents of Drinks: Experimental Test on Natural Consumption Behavior (RC1 AA019004, Lange PI, \$702,873). The purpose of this project was to develop and test brief communications of nutrition facts and alcohol contents that a) individuals can effectively use to monitor their consumption, b) can motivate them to drink moderately, and c) could be required within bar and restaurant menus by future policies. 2009-2012.
